

Spot Counseling/Admission Notice (5th and 6th September, 2019)

B. Tech., M. Tech., M.C.A. 1st Year and B. Tech (Lateral Entry) & M.C.A. (Lateral Entry) spot Counseling 2019-20 to various disciplines of Bipin Tripathi Kumaon Institute of Technology, Dwarahat for vacant seats after the first spot counseling and dropouts will be held on 5th & 6th September, 2019 at BTKIT Dwarahat campus, as per the following schedule:

- 1) Date of reporting (B.Tech./M.Tech./M.C.A.): 5th September, 2019 (9:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.)
- 2) Date of counseling (for B.Tech/M.C.A./M.Tech.): 6th September, 2019 (10:00 A.M. onwards) (Only for those candidates who have reported on 5th September, 2019)
- 3) M. Tech. programs: reporting and written test (for non-GATE/non-UKSEE-2019 candidates) will be held on 6th August 2019 (10:00 AM) at institute campus.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

- The seats are limited. Please check the availability of seats on the website www.kecua.ac.in regularly. The seats shall be filled as per the norms of Uttarakhand Government.
- Merely reporting at spot counseling does not guarantee counseling and admission.
- Cash will not be accepted. Candidates are advised to arrange DD in advance.
- The candidates are required to come prepared with all documents as listed above.
- Counseling will be continued only up to the availability of the seats.
- Since, the counseling will be held on next day of reporting, the candidates are advised to make their own arrangements for boarding and lodging.
- Already admitted candidates must report with DD of Rs.2000/- (non-refundable) and produce earlier admission letter at the time of counseling for upgrading the branch.

Admission Procedure through spot counseling

Admission to vacant seats of B. Tech. 1st year shall be done as per the following procedure:

- A. Reporting: The candidates desirous of seeking admission must report at the reception counter of the counseling venue on the reporting day i.e. on 5th **September**, 2019. They are required to fill the particulars in the register and collect the required forms.
- B. Processing Fee Deposition: The above candidates are required to deposit the processing fee of Rs.2000.00 (non-refundable) in the form of Demand Draft drawn in favour of Director, BTKIT, Dwarahat, payable at SBI KEC Dwarahat (Branch code: 10584). This fee is non-refundable under any circumstances.
- C. Documents Verification: After completion of steps A & B, the candidates are required to join the queue at documents verification counters. Candidates are required to submit one Set of documents and show the originals of the submitted documents.
- D. Counseling: All the reported candidates shall be called to appear before the admission committee in order of merit of JEE (Main) 2019/UKSEE 2019 Rank for the allotment of vacant seats or seats vacant from the left out and the seats to be vacated during up-gradation. The candidate will be denied counseling, if all the seats are filled before his/her turn. Seat allotment letter shall be issued to the candidates, who accept the seat from amongst the available seats at his/her turn. The candidates, who do not accept any seat, are advised to leave the counseling venue.
- E. Admission: The candidates, who have been issued seat allotment letter by the admission committee, are required to complete the admission procedure alongwith the submission of the Institute fee and are advised to report immediately after admission as the session has already been started.
- F. The admission criteria for M.Tech programmes:
 - i) On the basis of valid GATE score for GATE qualified candidates
 - ii) In case of unavailability of GATE qualified candidates, admission shall be on the basis of merit of UKSEE 2019.
 - iii) Further, the seats remain vacant after above steps the admissions shall be on the basis of merit of written test to be held on 6th **September**, 2019 at 10:00 AM at institute campus. The syllabus for written test shall be as per GATE 2019.
