B.Tech. 1st and 2nd Year (Lateral Entry) M. Tech. 1st Year and M.C.A. 1st Year Spot Counseling-
Institute Level (2026-27) to various disciplines of **Bipin Tripathi Kumaon Institute of Technology, Dwarahat** for vacant seats after the online counseling and dropouts will be held on from **03rd Aug to 07th Aug 2026** at **BTKIT Campus , Dwarahat**, as per the following schedule:

1) Date of Reporting & Registration:

Daily (9:00 A.M. to 1:00 P.M.)

2) Date of Counseling:

Same Day daily (from 02:00 P.M. onwards) - Only for those candidates who have reported same day morning.

For detail of vacant seats visit to Institute website (www.kecua.ac.in and www.uktech.ac.in). Candidates are required to bring the following documents in original, along with a set of photocopy, for counseling & registration and ensure confirmation of admission.

Documents Required:

1. All original documents and **TWO SET** of self attested photocopy of each.
2. JEE (Main) Admit card
3. JEE (Main) Score/Rank card
4. 10th and 10+2 mark sheet and certificates
5. Category certificate (SC, ST, OBC), if applicable
6. EWS certificate, if applicable
7. Sub-Categories certificates like, Armed Forces (AF), Freedom Fighter (FF) and Physically Handicapped (PH) etc. if applicable
8. Domicile certificate for state quota.
9. For TFW Candidates, Income certificate to be submitted, issued by competent authority not below the rank of Tehsildar
10. Character certificate from last attended school (in original)
11. T.C./Migration (in original)
12. Final Year Mark sheet (Only for B.Tech Lateral Entry, M. Tech/MCA Students)
13. Photo identity card (issued by Govt. agency/Aadhaar Card)
14. 06 Photographs (passport size)
15. Receipt of Institute fee (fee will be deposited through online mode)

****Candidates passed 12th with PCM for CSE, ECE, Mechanical, Electrical, Civil & Chemical Engg. and passed with PCB for Bio-Technology can also participate.***

- The seats are limited. Please check the availability of seats on Institute website www.kecua.ac.in regularly. The seats shall be filled as per the norms of Uttarakhand Government. Visit university website www.uktech.ac.in for more information.
- Merely reporting at spot counseling does not guarantee counseling and admission.
- Cash will not be accepted. Candidates are advised to make payment online/UPI.
- Candidates are required to come prepared with all documents as listed above.
- Counseling will be continued only up to the availability of the seats.

Admission Procedure spot counseling- Institute Level

Admission to vacant seats of B. Tech 1st and 2nd Year (Lateral Entry), M. Tech. 1st Year and M.C.A. 1st Year shall be done as per the following procedure:

A. Reporting:

Candidates desirous of seeking admission must report at Mechanical Engineering Department on the reporting day. They are required to fill the required forms.

B. Processing Fee Deposition:

Candidates are required to deposit the processing fee of Rs.2000.00 (non-refundable) online. This fee is non-refundable under any circumstances.

C. Documents Verification & Counseling:

After completion of steps A & B, candidates are required to join the queue at documents verification counters. Candidates are required to submit one **Set of documents** and show the originals of the submitted documents. After submitting required documents, admission committee will allot desired choice to the candidate as per his/her preferences. Candidate will be denied counseling, if all the seats are filled before his/her turn. Seat allotment letter shall be issued to the candidates, who accept the seat from amongst the available seats at his/her turn. Candidates, who do not accept any seat, are advised to leave the counseling venue.

D. Admission:

Candidates, who have been issued seat allotment letter by the admission committee, are required to complete the admission procedure along with the submission of the Institute fee and are advised to report immediately after admission **as the session has already been started**.

F. The admission criteria for **M.Tech programmes:**

- i) On the basis of valid GATE score for GATE qualified candidates.
- ii) Further, the seats remain vacant after above steps the admissions shall be on the basis of merit of percentage of B.Tech.
